

Charity Drive to Hyatt Lost Pines

Join our next touring event, a charity drive to the Hyatt Regency Lost Pines Resort and Spa in Lost Pines, Texas on Sunday, August 21st. A charitable contribution of \$25 per car is requested, with the funds to be donated to charity by LSR. Each participant will pay for their own lunch at the Hyatt Resort Major Neighbors Golf Club restaurant overlooking the golf course.

The meeting point is the Starbucks in Spring Valley, 8420 I-10 (in front of Home Depot) at I-10 west of Wirt Road, between Wirt Road and Bingle at 9:30 am. We will follow 'less travelled straight and *winding* roads'. Our route takes us thru Buescher State Park and Bastrop State Park. The two parks are connected by a 12-mile drive through the Lost Pines of East Central Texas.

Everyone gets a prize - freebies from Annual Porsche Parade in Savannah.

Route to Hyatt Lost Pines (total elapsed miles shown on each leg)

- Meet at Starbucks in Spring Valley, 8420 on I-10 feeder road (in front of Home Depot) at I-10 west of Wirt Road, between Wirt Road and Bingle at 9:30 a.m.
- I-10 W to Sealy Rte-36 N (Exit 720) – 40 miles
- Left at 1094 to New Ulm – 42 miles
- 109 S to 1291 (Freisburg) – 64 miles
- Stay on 1291 to Fayetteville – 68 miles
- Left on Rte-159 W – 78 miles
- Merge onto Rte-71 W/Rte-159 W – 92 miles
- On to Rte-77 N – 94 miles
- Left to Rte-153 (Winchester) – 100 miles
- Left onto 2104/153 – 115 miles
- Right onto P1 (Park Road) Buescher State Park, \$2.00 park entrance fee per adult – 118 miles
- Follow Park Road 1 C, 12 mile drive thru lost pines to Bastrop State Park
- Left out of park onto 21 W – 131 miles
- Right onto 71 W to Lost Pines Road – 138 miles
- Right on Hyatt Lost Pines Road to Hyatt Lost Pines – 140 miles

Route from Hyatt to Houston:

- Option 1 – Rte 71 E to Columbia, I-10 E to Houston
- Option 2 – Rte 290 from Bastrop to Houston
